- Financials discussed
 - First PPP loan has been forgiven
- Motocross on July 10, 2021
 - Volunteers needed at 5:45 AM through the afternoon to park cars. At least 16 volunteers needed first thing in the morning. Michelle is to type up a sign-up letter. Volunteers are to email or call Michelle in the office to sign up.
 - Unsure if the school is parking cars
 - Volunteers needed the night before (7/9/21) to set up. The grounds need to be mowed and weed whacked before the event.
- Fundraising for roof repair
 - Go-Fund-Me is up online thanks to Marc St. Onge
 - Kirk and Russ to meet with Latka Printing for a mail-in fundraiser. Jess Boldyga to get a statement from Rep. Boldyga in support of the Southwick Rec Center
 - Discussion on looking into various loans and grants to help with the roof like the CPC loan and Community Block Grant.
- Other sources of Income
 - Looking into pickleball
 - Spread the word about renting the building for functions. Rent price to go up on the website
- Soccer
 - HS Girls Team to use our fields for 6 games starting in July. They provided \$500 to cover insurance and to help maintain the field
 - Season coming to an end; optimistic about the fall season for travel and intown soccer
 - Follow-up on break-in at snack shack: Ray Foisy added bolts and someone is still trying to lift up the sliding window. Most likely kids trying to find snacks. SAP asked to make sure children are not near the building and to always lock the gate after using the field.
- Summer Sports
 - Season to finish on 6/17/21
 - T-Ball field has no infield so the committee would like it lined out and fixed for next season
- Basketball
 - Open gym time to happen a couple nights a week. Participants charged a couple days per night
 - HS students/young adults using the gym need to pay a one time \$15 insurance fee each and then as a group a small donation each time they utilize our gym
 - Floors need to be done before upcoming season in October
 - Talk to the custodians at the schools about what they use to wax their gym floors
 - CYO League to happen in upcoming year
- School-Age Program
 - Last day of school on 6/22/21
 - As of now, it looks like upcoming school year should be back to somewhat normal
 - Currently working on sign ups for 21-22 school year and going through the waitlist
