Frequently Asked Questions:

- Q: How long is overtime?
- A: 3 minutes in the regular season. Full period in the playoffs.
- Q: Who shoots first in the shootout?
- A: The away team starts the shootout process followed by the home team. The two teams will alternate through the rounds until a winner is determined.
- Q: Are there shootouts in the playoffs?
- A: No.
- Q: Are the white poles extended above the plexiglass in or out of bounds?
- A: The white poles are considered out of bounds.
- Q: Is high sticking at the letters or the waste?
- A: High sticking per the SRC rule book states that "A high stick violation, (on the backswing or follow-through while in the act of shooting), shall be determined by the height of the shooter's knee on the backswing & waist on the follow-through. A violation will result in an immediate stoppage of play and a face-off at the nearest face-off spot. A violation by a player in their offensive zone will result in the face-off being conducted at the nearest face- off spot outside that player's offensive zone.
- Q: When do faceoffs go all the way back to the offending defensive zone?
- A: Only on penalties.
- Q: How many coaches/adults are allowed behind the bench?
- A: 2
- Q: How many timeouts are there?
- A: 1 per game during regulation time & 1 per overtime period.
